Dress Code Policy 2017- 2018 Sheldon Clark High School

Appropriate clothing is expected of all students at Sheldon Clark High School. Clothing must be appropriate for school and must not interfere with the educational process.

- 1. Clothing or accessories cannot have anything obscene, drug related, etc.
- 2. Pants, shorts, and skirts must be worn around the waist. They also cannot have holes in them above knee.
- 3. Shorts, skorts, dresses, and skirts length must be no more than 3 inches above the knees. This includes the shortest part of the garment. No undergarments are to be seen at any time sitting or standing.
- 4. No sleeveless shirts/tops allowed. No shirts that have the cutout (cold) shoulder where the shoulder is exposed. Tops cannot expose any part of the skin at the stomach, back or chest at any time.
- 5. Clothing that is too tight, too loose or see-through or "transparent" clothing is not allowed. Under clothing must not be visible at any time. Spandex-type clothing is not permitted unless it is worn as an undergarment, and the over garment must adhere to dress code. If leggings are worn, the top must fall below the hips.
- 6. Hats, sun visors, sunglasses, or bandannas are not to be worn or seen in the building. If they are seen, they will be confiscated.
- 7. Hoods must be fully down at all times while in the building.
- 8. Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times.
- 9. Clothing or accessories that could be harmful or dangerous is not allowed. Teachers and/or principals will make that decision.

These rules are for the safety of all students.

Any faculty or staff member who observes a dress code violation may send the student to the principal or assistant principal. Based on the dress code, the principal/assistant principal will determine if the clothing is appropriate.

1st Dress Code violation – Must change clothes and a warning

 2^{nd} Dress Code violation – Must change clothes and a call home will be made

3rd Dress Code violation – Discretion of the principal
