

**Policy 4.062**  
**Martin County High School**  
**Cell Phone Policy**

Rationale: To provide a safe school environment that minimizes distractions from the educational process.

In addition to the district policy, Martin County High School will also be including the following consequences for cell phone abuse:

1<sup>st</sup> offense – phone taken to the office. It may be picked up at the end of the day by parent/guardian or anyone on student’s pick up list.

2<sup>nd</sup> offense – phone taken to the office, lunch and break detention.

3<sup>rd</sup> offense – phone taken to the office. One day of ISS.

4<sup>th</sup> offense and thereafter – phone taken to the office. Discipline at the discretion of the principal. Depending upon the cell phone violation, students could lose their privilege to have a cell phone at school. (e.g. videoing fights, social media bullying, having inappropriate material on phones)

Phones are to be put away and turned off from 8:00 until the end of the school day with the exception of during lunch and break times.

During class time, faculty and staff’s personal cell phones should be put away.
