

11. GRADES AND ATTENDANCE POLICY

The Martin County High School Department of Athletics shall abide by the KHSAA Standards for grades for athletes. Student athletes must maintain a 2.0 GPA for each nine-week grading period in order to be eligible to play. It is coach's responsibility to conduct frequent grade checks in order to monitor eligibility.

The Martin County High School Department of Athletics shall abide by the School-based Decision Making Council (SBDM) attendance policy. This states that an athlete must attend school the day of a game and the day after a game. (exceptions will be made if returning from an away game after 12:00 a.m. the night before). Also, on the day of the game, student athletes are not permitted to be tardy or check out of school prior to dismissal.

Unexcused tardies to school and for leaving school prior to dismissal will follow the same system of punishment as unexcused absences.

4 unexcused tardies to school or leaving school early – one day of ISS and loss of exemption card.

5 unexcused tardies to school or leaving school early – two days of ISS

6 – 9 unexcused tardies to school or leaving school early – loss of next field trip, loss of participation in any part of the play, loss opportunity to participate in club and club associated competitive events.

10 unexcused tardies to school or leaving school early – loss of homecoming and/or prom if a junior or senior.

11 or more unexcused tardies to school or leaving school early – principal's discretion

12 unexcused tardies to school or leaving school early – loss of senior week activities or if not a senior, principal's discretion

Tardies will be reset at the end of the semester. They will not carry through the year.

Qualifications for Exemption Cards for Semester Exams

Exemption cards are given to students as a reward for attendance. These may be used in any participating class to exempt a semester exam. Students may receive two exemption cards per year, one for each semester.

Qualifications to earn exemption cards are as follows:

- Student may not have more than one absence, whether it be excused or unexcused, during the semester.
- Student may not have more than three (3) unexcused tardies, whether it be coming to school late or checking out early. In order to use their exemption card for a participating class, they may not have more than (3) unexcused tardies per semester in that specific class.

Unexcused tardies during the school day, between classes (periods 2-7) will have the following consequences:

From the first tardy students will be assigned break detention and lunch detention. Every consecutive tardy thereafter, student will have break and lunch detention. A list of students serving break and lunch detention will be e-mailed by ISS teacher to staff daily. If the assigned student does not report to ISS, they will then be assigned two days of break and lunch detention. Following three tardies for the same class, the student will be assigned one day of ISS.
